



CCA To Hold Special Film Night on President's Day

Three student films and a motion picture nominated for an Academy Award will all be shown at a special CCA Film Night at Wildwood Church on Monday, February 18 (the President's Day holiday).

The event, which runs from 6 to 8 p.m., is designed to showcase CCA's Film Studies program – and to give CCA students a chance to invite their friends, neighbors, and loved ones to an evening of fun and learning.

The featured attraction of the evening is the 33-film, "Most," which was originally shown at the Sundance Film Festival and later nominated for an Academy Award. Set in the Czech Republic, the film has a powerful storyline that parallels the gospel in a moving and memorable way.

Three student films will also be shown. Two are productions by CCA high school students in Mrs. Hill's Film Studies class; and the third is an eight-minute film shot on location at CCA by a film crew from the FSU Film School. (This film includes cameo performances by a number of CCA students, parents, and faculty.)

Panel discussions featuring a number of CCA's upper school students will follow each showing. Popcorn and soft drinks will be served during intermission.
